AROUND THE CONFERENCE

The **English and Spanish Women's Retreats** combined hosted almost 1,000 women during the weekends of January 27-29 and February 3-5, 2012. These weekends at Tenaya Lodge are a time of fellowship, edification, encouragement, witnessing (almost 1/5 of the ladies were non-Adventist), and spiritual revival. Pass the word along, next year's events are scheduled—English, January 25-27, and Spanish, February 1-3, 2013.

The **Hispanic Convocation** on February 10-11, 2012 in Bakersfield, culminated a week of revival with Dr. Neftali Miranda and resulted in four baptisms. The hundreds in attendance were blessed!

Bakersfield Central's meetings with Conference Evangelist Taj Pacleb closed February 25, 2012. More than 40 people made decisions for baptism—19 new members were baptized this past Sabbath. Taj will come back on Sabbath, March 2, to assist with baptisms and also to conduct a wedding. On opening night, 300 plus people came—100 were guests, too many for the round table seating for eight in the fellowship hall. All guests and as many members as possible were seated for supper. But the meetings, usually held with people sitting around the tables, had to be moved to the sanctuary. Taj describes the nightly meals as “gourmet food!”

By the way, Taj and his wife Wati begin meetings at **Fresno Central** on March 2, 2012.

The **Visalia English** church family hosted the *Babylon Rising* series with John Bradshaw. (The It Is Written seminar was broadcast around the world from Las Vegas.) Pastor Chad Stuart reports there were 16 baptisms at the meetings' close. And two of those were a couple who are the first members of the ARK, the one-year-old church plant sponsored by the Visalia congregation. The church plant group meets on Sabbath afternoons.

The annual **Bible Challenge**, sponsored by the CCC Office of Education, took place Sabbath, February 11, 2012, at the Clovis church. Students from 10 schools participated answering detailed questions about the Book of Revelation. Students representing Miramonte Elementary took first place, with Bakersfield Adventist Academy taking a close second. I had the pleasure of judging the event along with Ken Bullington, associate superintendent, and Jeff Zahn from Central Valley Christian Academy. I was extremely impressed with the dedication and commitment of all participants. They fielded a series of very difficult questions some of which I don't think I could have answered. I know the study of the Book of Revelation will be seared in their minds for the rest of their lives.
