Conference Evangelist **Taj Pacleb** has been very busy. Attendance at **Bakersfield Central** meetings was beyond expectations with 100 guests and 300 members. On opening night there wasn't enough room in the fellowship hall at the round table seating for dinner and the seminar. Meetings had to be moved into the sanctuary. Highlights included a wedding and 31 people joining the Adventist church.

Fresno Central grew by 20 members at the end of meetings with Taj and 10 others are preparing for baptism. Nightly guests averaged 45-50. The round table dinner and meeting model was very effective. Church members visited attendees and made calls when attendees missed a meeting. Praise God! Please keep them in prayer.

Additional outreach results reported are: four baptisms in **Caruthers**, three baptisms in **Exeter** with four others studying, 20 baptisms at **San Francisco Samoan**, eight baptized in **Watsonville**, 17 baptized at **Bakersfield Hispanic** where Pastor Cesar De Leon preached, and in **Ceres** 20 people will be baptized in the next few weeks.
